OUR STORY




- Reicks View Farms was founded by Dale and Laura Reicks in 1979
- Began with 240 acres of corn along with 200 sows
- Today, Reicks View Farms prides itself on being a family farm with over 450 employees and 130 production partners




PORK PRODUCTION




- Approx. 65,000 sows = ~1% of all US pork produced
- 13 sow units: 12 of 13 green field sited by RVF (no acquisition)
 - 11 company owned
 - 2 contract farrowing agreements
- 710,000 nursery and finish spaces
 - 30% company owned spaces
 - 70% contract grower spaces
- Genetics
 - Internal boar stud
 - PIC Multiplier herd in Iowa

FEED PRODUCTION






- Own Feed Mill that...
 - 85-90% of total need
 - 10,000T a week
- Have an average of 700 semi loads a week of incoming and outgoing ingredients

GRAIN PRODUCTION



- 14,000 acres of corn in Iowa Produces approx. 1/4 of our corn needs
- 2.8 M bushels of storage
- Fertilize 9,000 to 10,000 acres per year with manure
- Own manure application equipment
- Manure Management Plans developed internally
- Handle DNR submissions and audits internally



TRANSPORTATION





- We move 90,000 pigs weekly
 - 30,000 weaned pigs
 - 30,000 nursery pigs
 - 30,000 market hogs
- 100 semi tractors and 150 vehicles
- 200+ trailers washed and disinfected each week

REICKS VIEW RENEWABLES

- Three solar arrays with over 664 panels
- Avoided over 1300 tons of Carbon Dioxide emissions
 - Equivalent to...
 - Planting 17,000 trees
 - 241,309 gallons of gasoline offset
 - 2,260 MWh of lifetime electricity produced



MLR FOUNDATION

The Melissa Lea Reicks Foundation was created in memory of Dale and Laura's daughter who died as a result of a car accident in 2003. She was 21 and entering her senior year at lowa State University.

The Foundation aims to serve the local communities across Northeast Iowa sponsoring schools, youth activities, churches, hospitals, town celebrations, and benefits. In 2021, the Foundation sponsored over 100 local and state organizations.


PRRS

LABOR


- Shrinking Labor Pool
 - Likely not going to get better
- Solutions
 - Increased Wages (approx. 15-25% increase post covid)
 - Attempts at more flexible scheduling (yet TBD)
 - Team Rewards Program
 - Managers Meeting
 - H2A and TN Visa Program
 - "Perm" Program / Path to Citizenship
- Company Labor in Contract Finishing barns
 - Generational Transfer
 - Value of employee labor vs. contract labor


